ABOUT

Club Mudgee partnered with the Mudgee RSL Sub Branch and started an Anzac Poppy Research Competition in 2016. With 3 prizes being on offer, 1st prize \$300, 2nd of \$200 and 3rd of \$100 to go to the school to help with resources, and the winning students receiving a gift from the club.

The Club purchased 100 poppies with Australian Soldiers names on them as part of the 100-year Anzac celebration. The Students all receive a criteria and research links to assist them with their project.

The poppies were distributed among the local schools with year 5/6 students taking part in the research competition.
