

Club Mudgee Dress Code

Suitable and appropriate clothing is required to be worn when attending Club Mudgee. Contemporary standards and common sense are the grounding principles of the dress code. Club patrons are expected to dress and respect Club Mudgee.

Dress regulations apply to children 15 years and older. Children aged 14 years and younger are required to dress in neat and age appropriate attire.

Club management reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone if, in their opinion, their standard of dress or behaviour is considered unsuitable for the club.

Key points

- Neat, clean casual dress and neat clean work attire is permitted at all times
- No revealing, provocative or immodest clothing
- Clothing and footwear must not be ragged or unclean
- General appearance should not be disheveled or unkept
- Clothing must not feature offensive messages
- No bare feet at any time
- Fancy dress costumes need to be pre-approved by management

Not permitted at any time:

- Short shorts and miniskirts that expose the buttocks or crotch when walking, sitting or standing
- Undergarments worn as clothing
- Motor cycle gang colours & fight apparel
- Bathers, bikini tops or similar beach wear
- Football / soccer or studded boots
